Interactive Writing Intervention - Level 1

The goal of Interactive Writing (IW) is to help students understand and apply early reading and writing behaviors. This intervention is intended for students who are not yet accessing print or are not able to read beyond patterned texts at levels A or B. Students in this intervention are typically in kindergarten or first grade. There are several components of the Interactive Writing Intervention. Upon completion of this 2-day training, participants will know how to implement the IW intervention.
