Writing Aloud Intervention - Level 1

The Writing Aloud Intervention is designed for students who are reading at a higher level but are experiencing difficulty with writing. The Writing Aloud Intervention apprentices the students in the writing process. Students learn problem solving strategies for writing as well as how to become self-regulated using resources for writing. Composing, drafting, revising and editing are addressed through this intervention. Additionally, students learn crafting techniques, organizational structures and vocabulary related to specific types of writing. Typically this intervention is used with students in grade 2- upper grades.
