Language Development and Literacy Learning for Pre-Kindergarten/ Kindergarten: Aligning to PCL

Building on 4K-5K Sessions 1 & 2, in Sessions 3, 4 and 5, the focus will be on developing a unit plan appropriate for the first month of instruction for the upcoming school year. In each session, there will be a discussion of the why of appropriate practice for K4 and K5 children, modeling and planning for instruction. In Session 6, we will give time for school teams to plan and share some of their thinking with the whole group. We will provide ways to share across the districts using technology including Google docs and common planning templates.
